A NEW PURPOSE FOR plastic bags

"Paper or plastic?" is a question that is soon to be obsolete — and rightfully so — as people opt for more environmentally friendly, reusable shopping bags. This change in the way we live our lives, and in the way we shop, is definitely a step toward a better world for us all, but now we are left with a new question: "What to do with all of these old plastic shopping bags?" Artists Tracy Schultz, Kim Thomas, Cheryl Hall, and Christine Risenis have reinvented plastic shopping bags, combining fashion, function, and earth-friendly sensibility.

green on the go

The spirit of the green movement inspired artist Cheryl Hall to use plastic shopping bags for a new way. "With more people riding bikes for transportation, I thought it would be nice to create a bike bag that also reflected the practice of green living," Cheryl explains. Cheryl's bike bag experiment was only plastic bags, but she got an old pair of denim jeans — something everyone has lying in the back of their closet. The bag had functional top handles for the bike rack on the go.

Cheryl cut a pair of jeans, cut under the crotch, and then sewed the bottom closed, creating a bag. She used Alena's Crystal Clear Tacky Spray to adhere two plastic bags together, and used them to line the inside of the bag. Cheryl trimmed the excess plastic, leaving 1/2 inches to fold down over the top of the bag, which she adjusted using Alena's Fabric Fusion. To allow the bag to hang from the backrest of a bike, she belts were added to the bag with Alena's Fabric Fusion. The bag can be filled with both items that aren't outside, like magazines, or with necessities like a cell phone, keys, and a bottle of water — anything an earth-friendly bicyclist may need while out and about.

Some words that may come to mind when hearing the word "cardboard" typically range from "bland" and "plain" to "bland" and "boring." However, Lisa Guerin and Betsy Coburn view it in an entirely different light. They gave cardboard a completely new meaning and corresponding set of adjectives including "pretty," "innovative," "fun," and "decorative." After you see what these artists created, you will never be able to look at cardboard the same way again.

a gift within a gift

Have you ever spent a lengthy amount of time selecting wrapping paper, only to see the recipient barely stand in awe? This is never an issue with Betsy Coburn — she wants people to enjoy their presents before even opening what would be inside. For this reason, Betsy enjoys making personal and beautiful presentations for gifts by converting single sheet cereal boxes and small food packages into gift boxes.

Betsy "killed the idea that they were throwaway, even if the use materials started out that way," she says. The friends and family that Betsy shares these with tend to cherish or reuse them, they are truly a gift within a gift. Betsy created each box by first cutting off the flap from the top and creating the bottom with tape. Reinforced with the flaps, drawings, and advertisements, Betsy uses no tape or staples (clippings from some 1960s and 1970s magazines also found at a vintage flea market). The two top flaps fold into strips, and unattached and attached them into the top inner edge of the box with slightly diluted white glue and a toothpick. Also using the corner edges with acrylic paint in various shades, she cut a flower inside from cardstock, added gold glitter and a button to the center, covered the petals with a pencil, and hot glued the finished flower to the box.

In when I found an unused planner in a recycle bin at work, it occurred to me that to time had been wasted. And, well, I just couldn't have that!
